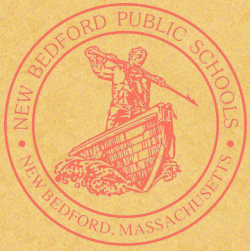
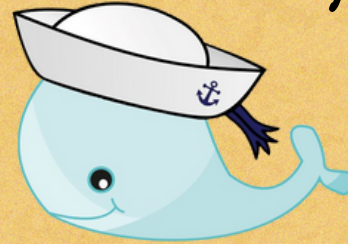




# Transition from Early Intervention to Preschool



As your toddler approaches his or her third birthday, early intervention will work with you to plan your child's transition from early intervention and, *if eligible*, to preschool special education services.



## 01

### REFERRAL

- Early intervention sends a *referral* to the Local Education Agency, which is the school district, 90 days before 3rd birthday.
- The school district will call to make an appointment to have child registered.
- At the age of 2.3 to 2.9, EI will schedule a transition meeting.

- At the age of 2.3 to 2.9, EI will schedule a transition meeting with you and the school district.
- At this meeting we will discuss and share information about your child.
- The team will discuss referral, evaluation and eligibility process as well as any questions you may have!

## 03

### CONSENT

*After TPC meeting:*

Consent to test is sent to you, the parent or guardian, along with a copy of procedural safeguards.

Once the consent is signed and received by the district, a Special Education Facilitator will contact you to schedule the evaluation.

### ELIGIBILITY

## 04

Evaluation will be completed within 30 school days. Within 45 school days the team will meet to review testing and determine eligibility and services through the New Bedford Public School Department.

If the child is eligible, an IEP will be developed.
